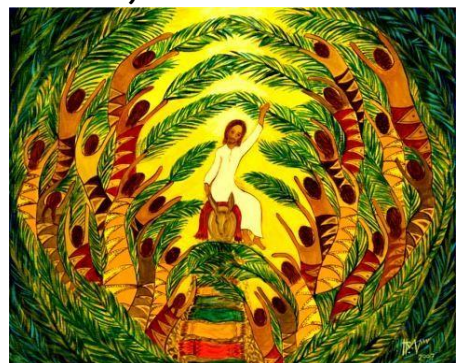
Mark 11:1-11 dramatised reading including:
