A Psalm may be said or sung preceded by an introduction and ending with

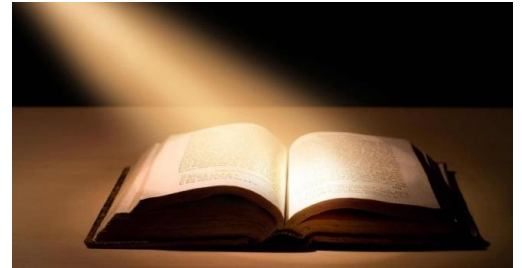
**All Glory to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit;
