## VICAR'S VIEW

I had the privilege of enjoying a reflective walk in the Surrey Hills with Bishop Jo this week. She was reflecting on how we use metaphors to help us understand God better, even though none is ever perfect. She chose the metaphor of a dog (God backwards of course) and I was struck by her slight rewrite of Revelation 3:20 – "Behold I sit by the door and wait. If anyone hears my bark and opens the door I will come in and be with him and he with me", because it reminds me of how God is often there, like a dog outside the door, waiting hopefully for us to open the door, so that he can be with us and we can be with him.

Dogs love our company and want to be with us, but can be shut out. Is our door open to God this Eastertide, because if not, open it wide and let him come in and bring you joy, love and make you feel that you are the most special person in the world (which you are). Jonathan
