Messy Church takes place this afternoon. Our theme is of Advent and Preparation. One of the crafts we will be doing is creating potpourri.





## **REV BEV'S REFLECTION - Waiting with Hope**

Today, the Feast day of Christ the King, the church's liturgical year ends with the announcement of Jesus' universal Sovereignty as we anticipate his return as Christ the King and judge in the Second Advent. Leading up to and during the Advent season, Scripture emphasises Jesus' Second coming with its themes of apocalyptic prophesy, remaining faithful, judgement, and hope in the promise of eternal life. These themes tell us to stay alert as we watch and wait for Jesus to return. But how do we wait for God? 'Waiting for God is essential to our spiritual life' (Henri Nouwen).

So as we approach this Advent, this new beginning, let us take the time to do our own Spiritual MOT, whilst pondering questions such as: To what extent do I wait on God? Where do I see God at work in the world today? What do I need to do differently, less of, or more of, as I wait for Jesus to return? And let us truly say:

'I wait for the Lord, my soul waits, and in his word I put my hope'

(Psalm 130:5).
