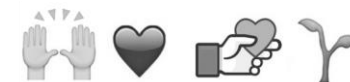

*** LENT COURSE ***

We will be running a Lent course called **Faith Pictures over 6 weeks from week beginning Monday 25 February** (the week before Lent, but so that it finishes before the Easter holidays) instead of Connect Groups, which is open to everyone whether or not you are part of a Connect Group.

Faith pictures is a video-based course with discussion produced by the Church Army designed to help Christians talk naturally to friends, neighbours and colleagues about what we believe.
