## \* NEW ELECTORAL ROLL – 2019 – LAST CHANCE!\*

Once every six years every parish is required to prepare a completely new Electoral Roll – and this is the year! The Electoral Roll is the list of those qualified to attend and vote at the Annual Parochial Church Meeting where the elections take place for the PCC and the parish's representatives on the Deanery Synod. Anyone entitled to attend the APCM may raise any question of parish or general church interest. Notices about the preparation of the New Electoral Roll are displayed at all three churches – **the closing date is TOMORROW – Monday 8 April**

**Even if you have been a church member for many years, please do not forget to fill in an application form**, sign it and pass it to one of the churchwardens or directly to me so that you can be added to the new Electoral Roll. You need to be baptised and aged 16 or over and either resident in the parish or, if not resident, you need to have attended public worship regularly at one of our churches in the last six months.

I look forward to receiving plenty of forms by the closing date, but you don't need to wait until then! –

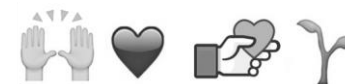
