SAM'S SCENE

We have just concluded 'Thy Kingdom Come', a global prayer initiative that was started by the Archbishop of Canterbury, Justin Welby, calling on all Christians to pray for evangelisation from Ascension to Pentecost.

But this does not mean that we now wait for Ascension next year to pray for others. I pray that this is something we continue doing. I was really encouraged by the testimony shared by the Archbishop of York, John Sentamu, who was using the palm of his hand and five fingers to pray for five people every day. The inspiration of this was Isaiah 49.16, "see, I have engraved you on the palms of my hands; your walls are ever before me."

With this in mind, can I encourage you to choose five people (family, friends, work colleagues, neighbours) especially if they have no faith at all. Pray for one person each day that God will reveal himself to them. And at the end of the five days, make a fist and pray, 'May your Kingdom come', offering the five people to God our Father. You will be amazed how much joy you get from your own prayer life doing this.
