The events committee are organising a quiz night at St Peter's Church Centre for the whole parish. It will be a fun evening with food and a great opportunity to invite friends. **Please put these dates in your diary now!**

*** NOTIFICATION OF MAJOR GAS WORKS – HIGH STREET & BROADMEAD RD ***

I am writing to make you aware of our forthcoming upgrade of our gas network in High Street and Broadmead Road, Woking. This essential work involves the replacement of old metal gas mains with new plastic pipe to ensure we continue to provide a safe and reliable gas supply to the local area. Our contractor Essex Utilities will undertake this work on our behalf.

So that we can minimise disruption, we have carefully consulted and planned our work in partnership with Surrey County Council. We have agreed to start our project on Monday 22 July; it will last approximately 6 weeks. Our engineers will be working in three phases as follows:

Phase One – High Street, between the junction of Church Street and Broadmead Road

- **We will begin our project on Monday 22 July**, working on High Street from the junction of Church Street towards the junction of Broadmead Road at the roundabout
- To ensure everyone's safety and maintain traffic flow we need to install temporary two-way traffic lights around our work area. These will move with us as we progress.

Phase Two – High Street, at the junction of Broadmead Road

- Once our engineers reach the junction of Broadmead Road at the roundabout we will need to install four-way temporary traffic lights on the roundabout for everyone's safety and to maintain traffic flow

Phase Three – Broadmead Road, between the junction of High Street and the River Wey Bridge

- Following on from phase three, our engineers will move away from the roundabout on Broadmead Road working towards the bridge over the River Wey
- For everyone's safety we need to install temporary two-way traffic lights around our work area. As in phase one, these will move with us as we progress along the

Our engineers will be working Monday – Friday between 8.00am and 4.00pm and if required, weekends between 8.00am and 1.00pm.

All work will be stopped, and the site cleared, between Friday 2 August and Monday 5 August. This is to minimise any potential disruption to the *Ride 100* event. High Street and Broadmead Road form part of the alternative route for *Ride 100* and as such for safety reasons we will not carry out any work during this event.

We understand that people can get frustrated by roadworks. However, the new plastic pipe has a minimum lifespan of 80 years. This means that when the work is complete, Woking businesses and residents will continue to enjoy the benefits of a safe and reliable gas supply for years to come.
