

VICAR'S VIEW

Approaching the Light Beacon on Westfield Common on Hallowe'en, having gone back to St Mark's to get something we forgot, it really shone out as a beacon of light on a dark night, as is its purpose symbolically.

Over the course of the evening we estimated over 250 people came and received hot dogs, soup, hot chocolate, glosticks, crafts and prayer. But a few hung back in the shadows, wary and unsure. This made me think how many of us hang back in our own shadows of fear, weaknesses and certain sins, afraid to come into the wonderful light of freedom, healing and forgiveness that Jesus brings.

As churches we want to be people who can be honest about their shadows and prepared to come into the light. Yes we will become vulnerable and exposed, but it's the only way to enjoy the fullness of life that Jesus wants to give us. Our ministry team and pastoral assistants are there to help anyone who would like to experience Jesus' light so please don't hang back, but come into the light! Ionathan
