**RACHEL'S RAMBLINGS**

*My grandmother died peacefully a couple of weeks ago at the age of 102. People used to ask what the secret was to such a long and healthy life and I'm sure porridge and early morning walks played their part but I think so too did her contentment; she didn't always have an easy life by any means but whatever her circumstances she was always ready to tell us 'It's a wonderful world'. She reminds me very much of St Paul, writing from prison:*

*"I know what it is to be in need, and I know what it is to have plenty. I have learned the secret of being content in any and every situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether living in plenty or in want. I can do all this through him who gives me strength."* Philippians 4:12-13
