

#### \* MARTIN'S MESSAGE \*

*Queen Elizabeth II has a strong Christian faith, evident throughout her life in her words and actions even before she was crowned.*

*A major influence were her parents. Both were devout Christians and her mother read the Bible to her and her sister every evening. She has a deep knowledge of scripture.*

*The passage she has quoted most in her Christmas speeches is the Parable of the Good Samaritan. But her favourite Bible passage, according to Billy Graham, is the healing for the invalid in John 5. Perhaps surprising friends, they first met in London in the 1950's and developed an unlikely friendship, visiting one another multiple times over the decades and Graham often preached in the Royal Family's private chapel.*

*In her Christmas message of 2002, she said: "I know just how much I rely on my faith to guide me through the good times and the bad. Each day is a new beginning. I know that the only way to live my life is to try to do what is right, to take the long view, to give of my best in all that the day brings, and to put my trust in God...I draw strength from the message of hope in the Christian Gospel."*

*She is an example to reflect upon. We wish her a wonderful Platinum Jubilee.*
