As I gaze out of the Warden's Window for the first time, I find myself reflecting on the calling of various Bible characters. Some were dramatic, like the apostle Paul who was struck down by a bright light and heard Jesus call his name. We also think of the call by God on the young Samuel; at first he thought the voice he heard call him was Eli's. Today in the book of Kings we see Elijah waiting for God to pass by, he didn't see him in the wind, the earthquake or the fire, but God appeared as a small whisper. Our stories of how we became Christians, or how we have felt called by God to take on various roles, will be many and varied. We may not be called to take on big tasks, but we may feel the call of God to write to a long-lost friend or to make a phone call. Sometimes these small acts may be the answer to someone else's prayer.
