



#### \* ENVIRONMENT TIP FOR SEPTEMBER - NEW \*

With the cost of food and fuel rising so quickly it's easy to think you can't afford to be eco-friendly in your weekly shop, as many products are that bit more expensive, but it is still possible to be eco-friendly on a budget. Bicarb, White Vinegar, Citric Acid and Castile Soap are cheap as chips and can be used to clean almost anything around the house without any unpleasant chemicals. Here's just a few ways to use them.

For shifting grease and grime in the kitchen and bathroom: dip a damp sponge in bicarb, work into grimy areas and watch the dirt lift – rinse!

<u>Descaling Spray</u>: Dissolve 2tbsp of citric acid in 500ml of warm water, decant into clean spray bottle and use as you would a standard descaling spray.

<u>Fabric softener</u>: Add 40ml of white vinegar to your dispenser drawer to keep your laundry soft with no vinegar smell afterwards!
