

* RACHEL'S RAMBLINGS *

St Martin in the Fields, where I'm on placement at the moment, has an amazing east window. It's simply made of panes of clear glass, crossed by vertical and horizontal lines, but in the centre an oval distorts and disrupts the lines so that they form the shape of a cross. It reminds me that Jesus came to bring a change of regime that would disrupt our world and our lives — as Simeon prophesied, he would cause the rising and fall of many people. He would disrupt neat, tidy, self-determined lives and set his followers on a new path, a cross-shaped path, to peace and freedom.

This is the wonderful path Georgia will embark on through her baptism today. One more thing about that window – at night it appears that the central oval is glowing, shining out in the darkness, shining out right at the heart of the cross that disrupted the world, shining out right at the heart of the cross-shaped lives of all who follow Christ – a light for revelation to the Gentiles and the glory of your people Israel.

May the light of Christ shine on Georgia and on each person who embarks on that wonderful, disruptive, cross-shaped path every day of their lives.
