*PCC HIGHLIGHTS – **NEW***

Our PCC met on Tuesday. Some of the highlights from the meeting are:

• <u>The 2023 financial accounts</u> were presented and approved. They show a small £4,000 surplus, which is encouraging, mainly due to an increase in calculation of Gift Aid owed.

• <u>Approval was given for a Community Garden</u> at St Mark's, which Lucy is organising with a team from church and the local community. Plans will be presented to St Mark's DCC in May.

• <u>A modified service pattern to start in June was</u> agreed. More details will be given after Easter, but key differences are:
