### \* LUCY'S LETTER \*

For centuries, Christians have been inspired by God's creation, worshipping outdoors as they marvel at God's goodness and abundance. And our very first Wild Church last Sunday was no different! We started by noticing our surroundings: hearing the birdsong, seeing the different plants interwoven in the lawn, feeling the breeze touch our arms and smelling the fresh air. We heard an ancient story told by Jesus about birds and flowers, recognising God's provision for all creation as we remembered not to worry.

We then split off into groups to do tasks around the site: litter picking, bug hotel-filling, dead-hedging, and preparing our shared meal. We picked a bag-load of rubbish from our woodlands, we squealed excitedly as we saw a toad, and screeched when we uncovered a red ant nest (which was quickly re-covered!). The 99-year-old and the one-year-old shared sticks to be added to the bug hotel, and we considered God as we worshipped by doing these tasks together.

Afterwards we reflected and prayed, then finished with a delicious home-cooked meal. The rain stayed away throughout, and we went home refreshed, having spent time with God in a different way, and with leftover food to take into the week.

Wild Church is open to anyone who wants to discover God in the outdoors. The activities will change as the Community Garden changes, the stories and reflections will be different each time. But what will remain the same is a group of people, gathered outdoors to marvel at God's goodness and abundance, just as Christians have done for centuries.


