If you are a tax payer please fill out a Gift Aid form so our Gift Aid secretary can claim it back. Standing order and Gift Aid forms are available in each church.
- 3. <u>Give in the weekly collection in church</u> you can put cash or a cheque made payable to 'The Parish of St Peter Woking' in the collection plate on Sundays and if you are a tax payer use the white envelopes at the back of each church to Gift Aid it. Or use the card reader at St Peter's which enables debit/credit card transactions.
