WHAT IS YOUR CARBON FOOTPRINT? - NEW *

A greenhouse gas (GHG) is any gaseous compound that is capable of absorbing and emitting infrared radiation (heat), allowing less heat to escape back into space, effectively 'trapping' it in the lower atmosphere. The major greenhouse gases in Earth's atmosphere are water vapour, carbon dioxide, methane, nitrous oxide and ozone. For example when you drive your car, buy new clothes, or eat a steak, you contribute to the emission of carbon dioxide and other the greenhouse gases into the atmosphere. In the UK each person is annually responsible for generating on average about 5 tonnes of carbon dioxide, and 1 tonne of the other greenhouse gases. The carbon dioxide generated is your carbon footprint and is the largest contributor to the total greenhouse gases.

The UK has committed to reaching 'net zero' (no longer adding to the total amount of greenhouse gases in the atmosphere, mainly through cutting greenhouse gas emissions) by 2050, with a 68% reduction by 2030. This will mean significant changes in what we eat, how we heat our homes, how we travel and what we buy. As an individual, you can also estimate your carbon footprint and reduce it. To find out how, take the test <u>https://carbon-calculator.climatehero.org</u>. Along the way you will be able to discover how to reduce your carbon footprint. Chris Heisig
