Thank you to the whole parish for holding me as I've been grieving this past month. To those who stepped in at the last minute to cover services at such a busy time, and to the whole parish who have been praying for me and sending kind words and thoughts my way: I am so very grateful.

My Mum's funeral is this Friday 10th, and I will be easing back into ministry over the coming weeks, though still a little bit wobbly and weathered!

In our parish daily Morning Prayer on the day that Mum died, we read Isaiah 43, and these words were specifically prayed over me, though I didn't yet know that she had died in the night. They have been a comfort to me over the last month, and I hope they bring comfort to anybody else who might be struggling at the moment:

"When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and when you pass through the rivers, they will not sweep over you. "When you walk through the fire, you will not be burned; the flames will not set you ablaze. For I am the Lord your God".
