*** STILL NEEDED! – HOLE-DIGGER ***

Would you be able to help prepare holes in the Garden of Remembrance at St Peter's for interment of ashes? We usually have 5-10 interments per year, mostly on Saturdays at 12 noon, and require someone to prepare the plot, ideally just beforehand, but it can be a day or so before and then manage records of the plots. Tools are available; it is not too strenuous.
